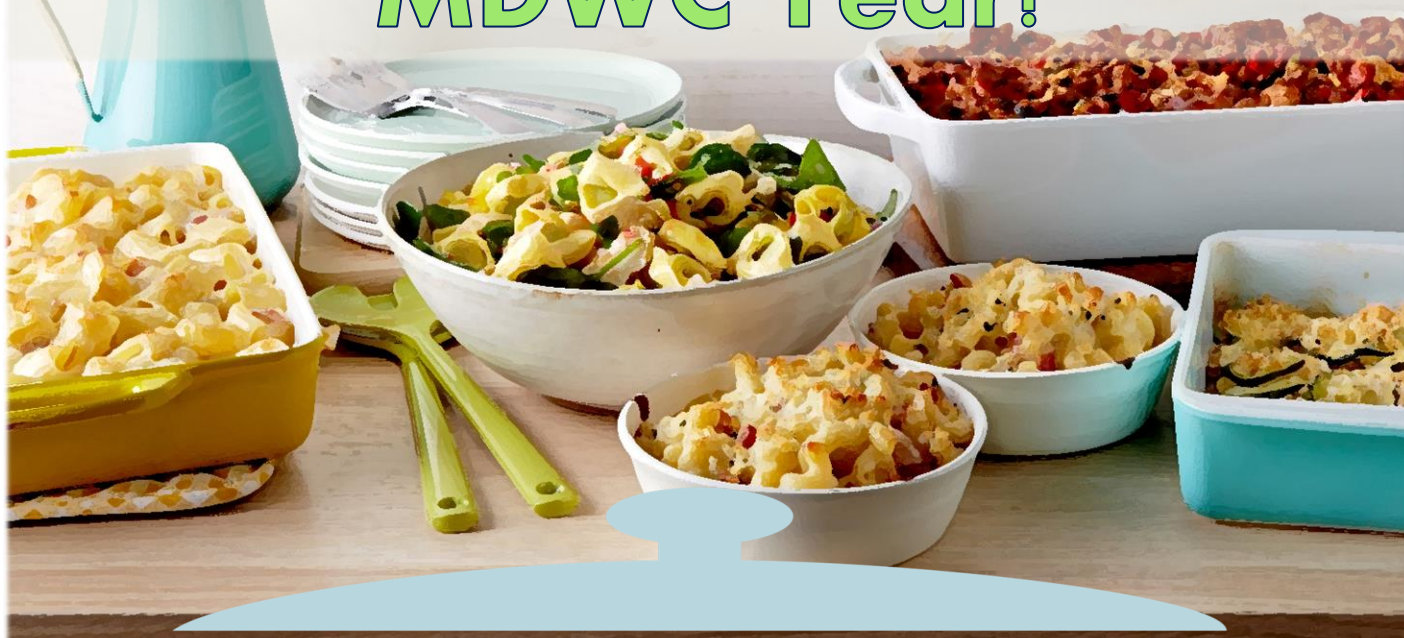

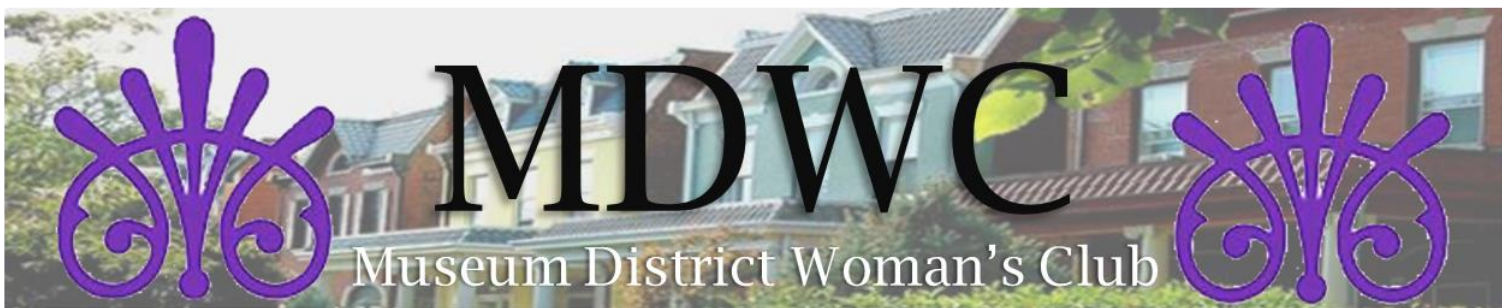

We had a great turn out at the progressive dinner this year and those of us who made it out know we had lots of fun. Let's see how much...

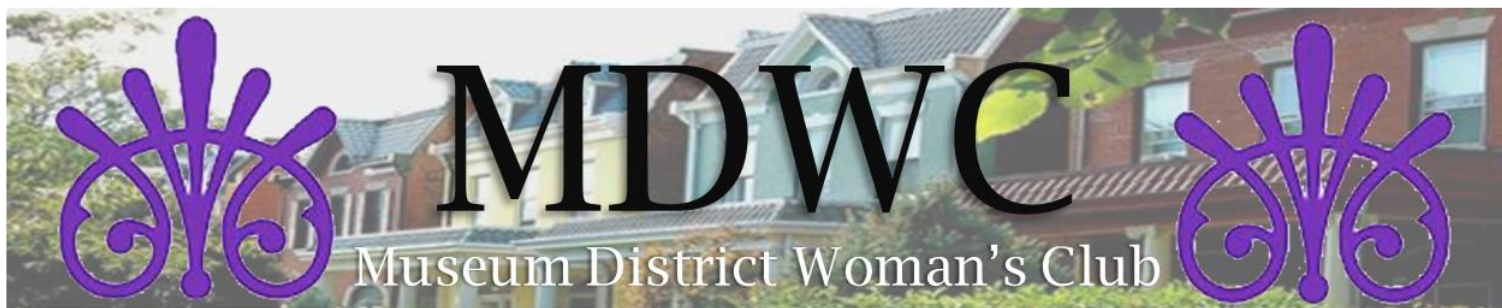
40 Tickets sold
